Boarding Information

We try to give as much value for your money as possible. It seems like boarding a horse these days costs as much as a mortgage payment!

- Full Care Board is \$550 per month, and includes daily stall cleaning, plenty of shavings, quality grain and hay, turn in/out per your requested schedule, blanketing/unblanketing per your request, boots on/off if needed. Provided supplements and medications are fed free of charge. Water buckets, feed bucket, blanket rack, and halter hook are also included.

- Field Board is \$275 per month, and includes pasture supplemented with quality hay during winter months, and year round shelter. Horse fed grain daily in a stall, blanketing unblanketing per your request. Provided supplements and medications are fed free of charge. Stalls available for grooming/tack up, and stall provided (for an additional charge) for sick or injured horse.

All boarders have use of all facilities. There are no hours at the barn, so you may come and go as you please. Our barn manager lives on the premises. Boarders also have use of the riding arenas, even when lessons are in progress.

Extra Benefits

- You are welcome to use your own blacksmith and vet. If you use the barn blacksmith or vets, holding horse is always free, and we schedule all vet and blacksmith services for you, and keep the schedule on our computer. We also have an equine dentist on staff.

- Our experienced trainer can provide training services for horses at any level.

- All boarders receive our monthly newsletter, and all boarders have their own mailbox, for easy communication. We also communicate with our boarders via an email newsletter.

- Boarders are welcome to join us at horse shows, both local and rated. We host several local shows here at the barn throughout the year. We also have a show team, which travels to shows throughout the year, for children and adults.

- We love to trail ride, and try to ride at the nearby public trails as often as possible. You are welcome to join us!

- You may have friends and family ride your horse, as long as we have a signed release form on file. You may also use one of our horses, for \$35 per ride, so you and a friend can ride together.

Ready to Move In?

Here's what we need from you:

- A copy of a negative Coggins within the last year, to be kept on file
- A signed boarder's agreement
- Proof of current vaccinations, including EHV-1 and Strangles.
- A completed vet, blacksmith and emergency information form
- Insurance company's name and phone number if horse is insured

Your board agreement is a one-year agreement. We realize, however, that circumstances sometimes change, so to end your agreement all we need is a 30-day written notice. All bills must be paid before removing horse.

Some Rules

- Your vet probably has your horse on a vaccination schedule. We require that all horses in our care have a negative Coggins test as well as a tetanus booster done every 12 months. We also require all horses to be vaccinated against EHV-1 and Strangles.
- All horses must have a Flu/Rhino vaccination at least twice a year; your vet may recommend a more frequent schedule.
- If your horse receives supplements in his grain, you will need to provide them. Many of our horses use SmartPak supplements, which we can order for you each month and bill you for their cost.
